

# Antigua and Barbuda sure power industries

Will Antigua & Barbuda use sustainable fuel for power generation?

The island of Antigua and Barbuda has taken the lead in utilising environmentally sustainable fuel for power generation, and this will be the first project of its kind in the Eastern Caribbean region where an LNG terminal will be coupled to a W&#228;rtil&#228; power plant.

What are the main industries in Antigua and Barbuda?

In Antigua and Barbuda, the fisheries and forestry sectors often considered as a subsector of the agricultural sector. Fisheries contribute about 50% of the GDP from all the agricultural sectors. This industry mainly caters for domestic consumptions, although export of the lobster catch is growing.

The financial service industry is dominated by both domestic and international banks, insurance companies, and other financial organizations. There are 8 commercial banks operating in the country. Antigua and Barbuda was ranked 98th out of 183 in the world in 2011 in the World Bank Ease of Doing Business Index.

What is the fishing industry like in Antigua and Barbuda?

The fishing industry employs about 1,200 people. The country has a fairly extensive fishing ground with a coastline of about 260 kilometers and a shelf area of 3,568 square kilometers. Because of the small-scale nature of the fishing industry, Antigua and Barbuda is a net exporter of fish products.

What is the importance of Agriculture in Antigua and Barbuda?

Agriculture is an important source of domestic income and employment for a significant number of people in Antigua and Barbuda. However, it contributes to a small proportion of the country's GDP. Over the past three decades, the contribution of agriculture to the GDP has significantly fallen from 40-12%.

Economy - overview: Tourism continues to dominate Antigua and Barbuda's economy, accounting for nearly 60% of GDP and 40% of investment. The dual-island nation's agricultural production is focused on the domestic market and constrained by a limited water supply and a labor shortage stemming from the lure of higher wages in tourism and construction.
