

What is the electricity sector in Armenia?

The electricity sector of Armenia includes several companies engaged in electricity generation and distribution. Generation is carried out by multiple companies both state-owned and private. In 2020 less than a quarter of energy in Armenia was electricity.

Does Armenia have energy resources?

Armenia has limited energy resources and can meet only a fraction of the total demand for energy from domestic resources. Armenia does not have oil or natural gas reserves and is thus highly dependent on imported energy resources. It imports oil and petroleum products from Russia, Georgia, Iran, and Europe.

Does Armenia have solar power?

In June 2016, the Armenian Parliament updated the law "On Energy Saving and Renewable Energy" which encourages the use of solar power in the country and allows users of solar installations of 150 kW or less to sell their excess energy back to the electrical grid. The voltage in Armenia is 220 V AC at a frequency of 50 Hz.

How does Armenia generate electricity?

Most of the rest of Armenia's electricity is generated by the natural gas-fired thermal power plants in Yerevan (completed in 2010) and Hrazdan. Upon gaining independence, Armenia signed the European Energy Charter in December 1991, the charter is now known as the Energy Charter Treaty which promotes integration of global energy markets.

What is Armenia's biggest energy consuming sector?

As Armenia's largest energy-consuming sector, buildings account for around 40 percent of electricity demand and more than 25 percent of gas demand.
