

Is China a world leader in hydropower?

As a result of the Three Gorges Dam and other projects, China became the world leader in hydropower in 2014, and as of 2019, it accounted for 30.1 percent of global hydroelectricity generation. Over the past decade, China has also emerged as a global leader in wind and solar photovoltaic (PV) energy.

How can China secure its future energy needs?

China is increasingly looking to secure its future energy needs with sustainable alternatives. In accordance with the 2016 Paris Agreement, China committed to make non-fossil fuel energy 20 percent of its energy supply by 2030 and to peak CO2 emissions by 2030.

Why is China turning to nuclear power?

China is also turning to nuclear power to decrease its reliance on fossil fuels. As of January 2022, China operated 53 nuclear power reactors, which generated a total of 50,769 MW of energy. Since 2019, China has trailed only France and the United States in terms of nuclear electricity generation.

China has nearly tripled its nuclear warhead arsenal since 2020, according to the Pentagon's latest China military power report released Wednesday. "DOD estimates the PRC ...
