

Which electric power company produces electricity in Greece?

As of March 2007, PPC S.A. (???) is the biggest electric power company in Greece, producing electrical energy in Greece.

Who is the largest power generation company in Greece?

It is the largest power generation company in Greece with a total capacity of 11.1 GW including thermal, hydro and RES power plants. HEDNO S.A., its 51% subsidiary, is the owner and operator of the electricity distribution network of Greece with a Regulated Asset Base of c. EUR 3 bn. With 70 years of history and eyes on the future!

Who owns a thermoelectric power station in Thessaloniki?

So far, Hellenic Petroleum's subsidiary, Thessaloniki Energy S.A., owns and operates a thermoelectric power station in Thessaloniki with a 390 MW installed capacity that is fueled with natural gas.

Greece owns and operates 34 major thermal and hydroelectric power plants and 3 aeolic parks of the interconnected power grid of the mainland. Additionally, there are 60 autonomous power plants located on Crete, Rhodes and other Greek islands (33 thermal, 2 hydroelectric, 18 aeolic and 5 photovoltaic parks).

Who owns 147 MW gas fired power plant in Viotia?

The 147 MW gas fired power plant in Viotia is owned and operated by Heron. It is designed to cover the system's reserve needs, as well as the needs in periods of high demand, over the following years. The total investment in this project reached 80 million euros.
