

How does the Dominican tax system work?

Todos los derechos reservados. The Dominican tax system is made up by Law 11-92, which sets forth its Tax Code (hereinafter "CTD"), as well as various complementary laws.

How has the corporate system changed in the Dominican Republic?

Since the entry of the General Law of Commercial Companies and Limited Liability Individual Companies, No. 479-08 (hereinafter "Law 479-08"), the corporate system of the Dominican Republic was updated. This law included new legal instruments and also transformed the existing corporate structures.

What type of government does the Dominican Republic have?

The Dominican Republic is politically divided into 31 provinces and a national district, where the capital city, Santo Domingo de Guzmán is located. According to its Constitution, the DR has an essentially civilian, republican, democratic and representative government, divided into three branches: Legislative, Executive and Judiciary.

What currency does the Dominican Republic use?

The DR is classified as a middle-income country, its national currency is the Dominican Peso (DOP or RD\$). Local exchange rate system is based on free convertibility. Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth for 2019 was 5.1%. The following sectors share the highest contribution to the DR's economy:

Why is Dominican Republic a CAFTA-DR member?

Dominican Republic's membership in CAFTA-DR provides U.S. exporters with significant advantages regarding tariff treatment. Taxes and duties for imported goods (agricultural and non-agricultural) are calculated on the "ad-valorem price," i.e., CIF (Cost+Insurance+Freight) price in U.S. dollars multiplied by the unified foreign exchange rate.

What taxes are collected in Dominican pesos?

All duties and taxes are collected in Dominican pesos. There are generally two taxes on imports except for those subject to exemptions provided by law. These taxes are the following: Tariff (Arancel, in Spanish): This is the basic import tax which can be as low as 0 percent and as high as 99 percent.
