

How much does a tank water heater cost?

Is a tankless water heater better than a storage tank?

Storage tank water heaters require little maintenance and are less expensive than tankless water heaters. On the downside, they use more energy. If you don't use stored hot water, it cools down and must continually be reheated. Tankless water heaters are also called instantaneous or on-demand water heaters.
