

# Heard and McDonald Islands cleanserve energy

What is the Heard Island & McDonald Islands Marine Reserve?

One of the world's largest highly protected IUCN category 1A marine reserves the Heard Island and McDonald Islands Marine Reserve was established by Australia in the waters surrounding HIMI in 2002.

Why should the Heard Island & McDonald Islands Marine Reserve be expanded?

The proposed expansion of the Heard Island and McDonald Islands Marine Reserve would protect unique marine and terrestrial areas of high conservation value. The islands and surrounding marine environment provide important habitat for many species and encompass a range of geomorphic features.

When is public consultation on the Heard Island & McDonald Islands Marine Reserve open?

Public consultation on the proposal to expand the Heard Island and McDonald Islands Marine Reserve and proposal to prepare a draft management plan for the reserve was open from 5 July 2024 to 5 September 2024. The public comment period has now closed.

Why are Heard Island and McDonald Islands isolated?

However, the site's isolation assists in reducing anthropogenic impacts upon the site's values. Heard Island and McDonald Islands are located in the Southern Ocean, approximately 1,700 km from the Antarctic continent and 4,100 km south-west of Perth.

Where are Heard Island and McDonald Islands located?

The islands are a territory (Territory of Heard Island and McDonald Islands) of Australia administered from Hobart by the Australian Antarctic Division of the Australian Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water.

Are Heard Island and McDonald Islands Endangered?

The overall assessment is that there is a low threat to the World Heritage values of Heard Island and the McDonald Islands if visitation remains low. Climate change, the introduction of non-native species and the potential expanding extent of *Poa annua* are the greatest threats to the natural values on the islands.

The Heard Island and McDonald Islands (HIMI) Marine Reserve was established in October 2002. The Reserve is a Commonwealth reserve, declared under section 344 of the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (the EPBC Act). ...
