Austronesian settlers reached the Marshall Islands as early as the 2nd millennium BC and introduced Southeast Asian crops,including coconuts,giant swamp taro,and breadfruit,as well as domesticated chickens,which made the islands permanently habitable.

What kind of vegetation does the Marshall Islands have?

Most of the Marshall Islands are true atolls,consisting of an irregular,oval-shaped coral reef surrounding a lagoon; the islets lie along the coral reef. The islands and islets of the Ratak chain tend to be more heavily wooded than those of the Ralik. Coconut and pandanus palms and breadfruit treesare the principal vegetation.

What is the capital of the Marshall Islands?

The capital and largest city is Majuro,home to approximately half of the country's population. The Marshall Islands are one of only four atoll based nations in the entire world.
