

Does Mauritania have solar?

TOUJOUNINE - Solar Averaging seven days of rain a year, Mauritania's climate is ideal for solar and the country's first major development in the sector did not disappoint in this regard with 54,000 panels supporting 50 MW production capacity at Toujounine, on the northern outskirts of the nation's capital.

Who owns Mauritania's electricity plant?

Completed in 2017, the \$53 million plant is run by the national electricity company, Soci t  Mauritanienne d'Electricit  (Somelec), and has seen ongoing works since its inauguration by (then) President Mohamed Ould Abdel Aziz, removing an estimated 57,000 tonnes of CO₂ per annum and supplying 10% of Mauritania's net energy production.

Does Mauritania have a green energy transition?

From zero renewables in 2008 to the 38% electricity mix share it boasts today, Mauritania's green energy transition has come a long way, rapidly accelerating in line with the urgency of the climate crisis.

Is Mauritania a low carbon country?

With a 38% share of renewables in its electricity mix and a 50% target by 2030, Mauritania is a top regional performer in the race towards low carbon power.

What is Mauritania's largest wind farm?

BOULENOUAR - Wind Set to come online in the fourth quarter of this year, the Boulenouar Wind Farm will be Mauritania's largest at 102.4 MW, exploiting the country's 754km of prime Atlantic coastline.

MAURITANIA PROJECT NOUR.
