

What subsidiaries does aradel holdings have?

Under the umbrella of Aradel Holdings, are the following subsidiaries: Aradel Energy Limited, Aradel Gas Limited, and Aradel Investments Limited (formerly known as Niger Delta Petroleum Resources Limited, ND Gas Development Company Limited, and NDEP Investments Limited, respectively).

How does aradel holdings invest in gas?

Additionally, Aradel Holdings through its subsidiary, Aradel Gas Limited, has invested heavily in gas through its Gas Processing Plant. The Plant has enabled the Company to develop and monetise its abundant gas resources in the Ogbel Field, through gas supply to domestic and export markets.

Does aradel Holdings own ND Western?

Aradel Holdings also holds a significant equity stake in ND Western, a consortium that acquired a 45% Participating Interest in OML 34 in 2012, and 95% equity in Aradel Refineries (formerly ND Refineries Limited), an independent midstream entity.
