Four decades on, a United Nations-controlled buffer zone splits Cyprus east to west. The zone still contains crumbling relics of times gone by - abandoned houses, businesses and even an airport. Cyprus, a former British colony, gained independence in 1960 and initially Greek and Turkish Cypriots shared power. It did not last.

Is there a buffer zone between Cypriots and Turkey?

A U.N.-controlled buffer zone now runs across the country, dividing the Turkish Cypriot north and the Greek Cypriot south. Although it is possible to cross the boundary through a number of checkpoints, entry to the U.N. zone itself is highly restricted. Many of the things inside - cars, houses, businesses - have been left to gather dust.

What happened to the water supply in Northern Cyprus?

The strict restrictions on water supply to households mean that people were receiving water for only 36 h per week, reducing independence and freedom [4,46]. Some parts of Northern Cyprus have been experiencing an unprecedented boom in construction and property sales.
