

How many MW is a solar power plant in the Ivory Coast?

The authorities in the Ivory Coast have completed a 37.5 MW solar plant, with a second development phase now underway to increase its capacity to 80 MW. The first phase of a solar power plant in the northern part of the Ivory Coast has been inaugurated.

How much solar power does Ivory Coast have in 2023?

Ivorian Energy Minister Mamadou Sangafowa Coulibaly has also revealed plans to expand the capacity of the Boundiali plant to 80 MW. Where will a floating solar power plant be located in Ivory Coast?

From pv magazine France Ivory Coast's state-owned energy company Côte d'Ivoire Energies (CI-Energies) has launched a tender for the construction of a floating solar power plant and the associated transmission network. The 20 MWp will be located on the retention lake of the Kossou dam, in the center of Ivory Coast.

Ivory Coast's first solar power plant represents a significant step towards a greener and more resilient energy future. By reconciling economic development and environmental protection, the country is showing the way to a successful energy transition.

How much solar power does Ivorian government need?

The Ivorian government is planning to meet increasing energy demand by adding around 150 MW per year through IPPs, according to the United States Agency for International Development (USAID). According to the International Renewable Energy Agency, the Sub-Saharan country had only 13 MW of installed solar power at the end of 2020.

How much does the Ivory Coast electricity project cost?

The project, which has a total cost of EUR75.6 million (\$81.8 million), is expected to power 70,000 homes, saving 60,000 tons of CO₂ equivalent per year. It is creating more than 300 direct and indirect jobs during construction. The project is part of efforts to diversify electricity production in the Ivory Coast.

The project will be the first solar Independent Power Project (IPP) in Ivory Coast and will be located at the city of Bondoukou in the north-eastern region of Gontougo, located 420 km northeast of Abidjan. At a total investment of around US\$60 million, the solar project is being fully developed by AMEA Power under a Build-Own-Operate and Transfer (BOOT) model and ...
