Does South Sudan have electricity?

... About 98% of South Sudan falls within the River Nile Basin with various water bodies all over the country (The Nile Basin Initiative (NBI), 2019). South Sudan has huge energy potential, from conventional to renewable energy resources, from which it can produce electricity (Bilali, 2020; Tiitmamer and Anai, 2018).

Why is South Sudan facing a serious energy crisis?

South Sudan faces a serious energy crisis due to a number of factors, including devastating conflicts (e.g. 1955-172, 1983-2005 & 2013-present) and reliance on the fossil fuel source. The country has the lowest energy consumption rate in Africa and the highest cost of producing energy (World Bank, 2016).

Is biomass a source of electricity in South Sudan?

Traditional biomass - the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter - is not included. This can be an important source in lower-income settings. South Sudan: How much of the country's electricity comes from nuclear power? Nuclear power - alongside renewables - is a low-carbon source of electricity.
