What happened to Wallis and Futuna?

Wallis and Futuna is an overseas community of France consisting of two small island groupings in Polynesia, near Fiji and Samoa. In December 2012, extensive damages to buildings and infrastructure on Wallis occurred when cyclone Evan passed through the area. Futuna, the smaller of the two islands, was relatively untouched.

In 1991, BNP Nouvelle-Cal&#195;donie, a subsidiary of BNP Paribas, established a subsidiary, Banque de Wallis-et-Futuna, in the territory. Two years earlier Banque Indosuez had closed its branch at Mata-Utu, leaving the territory without any bank. Following this, the Bank of Wallis-and-Futuna (BWF) with its head office in Wallis was created in 1991.
