

Why is the UK giving up sovereignty over Indian Ocean islands?

ABC/Reuters After years of negotiations, the UK is giving up its sovereignty over a cluster of strategically important Indian Ocean islands. The move has led to criticism from Britain's Conservative opposition and some local Indigenous groups.
