Will the demand for power continue to rise in Zambia?

While the Zambian government accepts that the demand for power will continue to rise in Zambia, it has taken the view that the demand will be much higher than the 95% projected under the COSS.

What will Zambia's energy demand look like in 2040?

The government anticipates that peak demand will be at 8,000 MW by 2030 and 10,000 MW by 2040 (from around 3,000 MW in 2022). It also projects that the demand will be largely driven by mining and agricultural consumers and not residential consumers as projected in the COSS (Government of Zambia, 2022). 4.
